

What is AWANA?

AWANA stands for *Approved Workmen Are Not Ashamed* which is found in 2 Timothy 2:15. AWANA is a fun approach to learning God's Word through games, contests, rewards and special events throughout the club year.

What do clubbers do at AWANA?

Clubbers play games, recite verses / work in their handbook, hear a message from God's Word and sometimes there's special events and treats.

How much does AWANA cost?

\$30 per child, due at registration.

- Visitors may attend for 2 weeks prior to full registration if space is available.

How will I know if club is cancelled?

We will have a schedule set out for the year. If there is a need for closure due to severe weather, we will contact families by email first and /or by phone and also post on our website.

- 3 Once you have completed registration pay by cash or cheque. To register or pay in person, contact us at 306-757-1825.

How Parents Can Help

- Encourage regular attendance
- Make sure your child wears the uniform
- Get your child to club on time
- Help or encourage your child to memorize the verses in their current section
- Encourage your child to spend 10 –15 minutes per day on their handbook. (For most kids, this is all it takes to learn or do the sections for the week)
- Attend all major events
- Let club leaders know about any medications, allergies or other conditions that may affect club participation
- Arrive on time to pick up your clubber (Clubbers must be signed in and out due to the church's child protection policy)
- Show interest in your child's accomplishment.

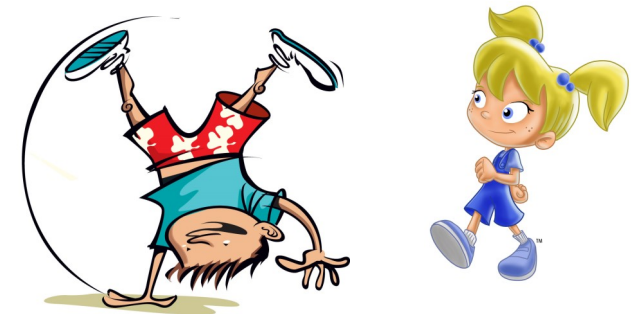

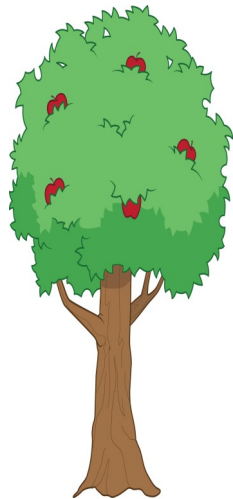

Game Time gives children the chance to play fun games while learning teamwork, leadership and communication skills.

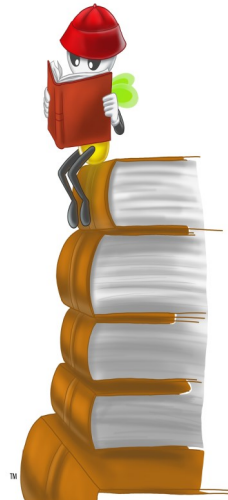


Kindergarten - 2nd Grade

Wear uniform vests to display patches earned for passing section in handbook.

Sparks is the Awana Club for children in Kindergarten, 1st grade and 2nd grade. Each club meeting has three parts. A Game Time, Green Meadow Time (age appropriate Bible lesson) and Sparkle Time, when clubbers recite Bible verses from memory, complete handbook sections, and earn awards.



Handbook Time provides children with the opportunity to develop relationships in a small group while reinforcing the Scripture memory work that they have done at home during the week.
